## WELCOME to JOY-FILLED MARRIAGE



To assist you with your marriage preparation ministry, we have created a five-step process for planning and conducting the *Joy-filled Marriage* program.





#### **STEP ONE**

### Dedication to Prayer



- 1. Prayer is foundational to the success of the *Joy-Filled Marriage* program for your diocese/parish. We suggest calling a convent or monastery in the area and requesting prayers for God's will to be done as you courageously share the meaning of marriage and witness marriage to engaged couples in your diocese/parish.
- As you build your marriage preparation team, share the importance of praying for the couples before each marriage
  preparation event and of praying for each other. Give your team members practical ideas on how to do this
  (i.e., Mass, Rosary, Adoration).
- **3.** You might consider sharing the following prayer with your team:

Heavenly Father, we praise you and thank you for the great gift of the sacrament of matrimony.

Increase your love in us, that your grace may form us as living witnesses to the Faith. You know our worries and weaknesses, yet in your loving mercy you have called us to courageously share the meaning of married life as teachers of Theology of the Body and how to build a virtuous marriage. Bless your people with hearts receptive to your word.

We ask this in the name of your Son, Jesus, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

### **STEP TWO**

### Select and Order Materials for Your Engaged Couples




### GOD'S PLAN FOR LOVE

God's Plan for Love provides couples with a rich understanding of the teachings of the Church and offers them the tools to live them out in married life. God's Plan for Love is a key element of marriage preparation—catechesis in the theology of marriage and the gift of human sexuality.

It will also be important to determine the model you plan to employ for your marriage preparation as well as the time you will take to go through the program. *Joy-Filled Marriage* was created to be flexible in order to fit time frames as limited as a single weekend or as expansive as multiple weekly meetings—or anything in between.



### DETERMINE THE STRENGTHS AND INTEREST LEVEL OF YOUR POTENTIAL PRESENTERS AND FACILITATORS

The following survey and worksheet are designed to help you reflect on the qualities needed in effective Joy-Filled Marriage leaders and facilitators for your circumstances. Keep in mind that the qualities needed may be different depending on whether you are using a mentor model, small-group model, or large-group model.

#### **COMMUNICATION SKILLS**

- Does the person (or couple) communicate well?
- Would they work best with engaged couples in a one-on-one setting or in a group setting?
- Are they more suited to expanding from the video presentations or presenting sessions independently?
- Can they "think on their feet" and answer difficult questions with clarity and prudence (keeping in mind that they will improve with experience)?

#### KNOWLEDGE OF CATHOLIC THEOLOGY AND ABILITY TO SHARE PERSONAL INSIGHTS

- How well does the person (or couple) understand the content of the Joy-Filled Marriage program?
- How well do they understand Catholic theology as a whole, especially the Church's teachings on human sexuality and marriage? (This is particularly important when presenting God's Plan for Love.)
- Are they open to sharing personal thoughts and insights regarding marriage?

#### **PASTORAL PRUDENCE**

- Do you sense that this person (or couple) would be pastorally prudent in dealing with engaged couples?
- Do they understand and have sensitivity to the issues engaged couples face?
- Would they work well with a wider team?

#### LEADERSHIP POTENTIAL AND AVAILABILITY

- Do you see this person (or couple) taking a leadership role?
- What particular gifts do they bring to your program? Do you sense that they are committed to marriage preparation ministry?
- How much time can they give to the program?

### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Will you offer each presenter (or couple) a stipend?
- Will you offer a stipend for travel expenses and babysitting?
- What are the specific needs of each presenter (or couple)?
- Would a stipend help to mitigate their concerns about participating in the program and/or bring stability and consistency to your program?

### DISCERNING THE PRESENTERS FOR EACH TALK

• Reflect on the content of each talk and identify which person or couple is best suited to present it, based on their knowledge, interest, and ability. (Remember: If you are using a team of presenters and facilitators, it is important to have all couples present as the sessions begin. If possible, match couples who work well together, i.e., those who will divide the workload equitably as they present the content of the program as a team.)

### STEP FIVE

## Prepare Your Budget - Group Model



#### **INCOME:**

- Determine the basic cost for running a one- or two-day event for engaged couples.
- Do you plan to recoup costs for your leadership training by adding in an additional amount to the engaged couples' registration fees?

The average cost of a one-day session typically ranges from \$75 to \$150. These fees typically include the cost of lunch and materials. A two-day session or a weekend retreat generally ranges from \$125 to \$250 per couple (including lodging). The rate for engaged couples will need to be determined based on your particular situation.

**EXPENSES:** Here is a typical breakdown of costs for the Joy-Filled Marriage event using the large-group model.

- Stipend for presenters: Typically ranges from \$100 to \$500 per day. If you have several speakers presenting, compensation could range from \$50 to \$100 per talk.
- Meals and snacks: \$25 to \$40 per couple
- Materials: Varies depending on the number of couples
- Room Rental: \$0 to \$500+
