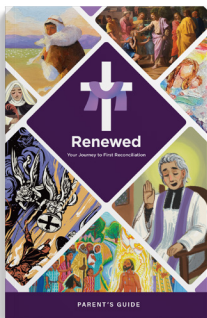

WHICH GUIDE SHOULD PARENTS USE?

The Parent's Guides



The Family Faith Formation (FFF) At-Home Guides



Sacramental prep using the *Renewed* and *Received* programs can take place in a classroom or at home. Parents have a vital role to play in both teaching models, but parents teaching a child at home need a different guide from parents whose child is being taught in a classroom.

In the classroom-based program, a catechist teaches the students, and the parents' role is supportive. The guides for parents of classroom-taught children are the *Renewed* and *Received* Parent's Guides. These printed books enable parents to reflect on what their child is learning, have engaging conversations with their child about the lessons, and answer some tough questions. The Parent's Guides also provide opportunities for parents to pray and journal as they find new ways to apply the child's lesson content in their personal and family lives.

In the home-based program, the parents are their children's main teachers, and they will use the *Renewed* and *Received* Family Faith Formation At-Home Guides. These at-home guides walk parents through each lesson in detail, showing parents what to say and do each step of the way.

1. Which editions of *Renewed* and *Received* can the Parent's Guides be used with?

The Parent's Guides can be used with both the first and the second editions of *Renewed* and *Received*.

2. Are these guides available as PDFs?

The Parent's Guides are provided as printed manuals, but they are also available as PDFs in the *Renewed* and *Received* Online Parent Certification Courses.

3. Can the Parent's Guides be used to teach *Renewed* and *Received* at home?

No. The Parent's Guides are designed for parents whose child is being taught in the classroom.

4. Can the Parent's Guides be used with the At-Home Guides?

We don't recommend using both, since they are designed for different teaching models and may be confusing if used together.

5. Are the Parent's Guides available in Spanish?

Yes.

Family Faith Formation At-Home Guides

(for parents who are teaching their children at home)



1. Which edition of *Renewed* and *Received* can the At-Home Guides be used with?

The At-Home Guides are designed for use only with the second edition of *Renewed* and *Received*.

2. Are the At-Home Guides available in print?

No, they are available only as free PDFs, although some parishes might print them out for parents.

3. Are the At-Home Guides needed when *Renewed* and *Received* are taught using the traditional classroom model?

No. The At-Home Guides are for parents who are teaching a child at home using the Family Faith Formation model.

4. Can the At-Home Guides be used with the printed Parent Guides?

We don't recommend using both, since they are designed for different teaching models and may be confusing if used together.

5. Are the At-Home Guides available in Spanish?

No.
